"Nominal thickness", as related to top fastening, has no consequence but "Screwing Up" with the Deckmaster system has length limitations.

The board's "true thickness" determines which kit to use.

Deckmaster has the highest uplift values of any hidden fastener system.

Measuring the actual deck board thickness assures you of the exact Deckmaster Kit you need for your job.

Red Box

All composites measuring less than 1 1/8". Hardwood decking measuring a minimum of 3/4". Any thickness hollow core composite decking.

Blue Box

5/4 wood decking. Composites measuring 1 1/8" or more.

Green Box

Deck boards measuring 1 1/2" or more.

Composite decking formulas and dimensions may be changed by the manufacturer at any time. Be sure to measure your batch of composite decking. Notify Deckmaster immediately if you are having difficulty installing any of the recommended applications. 800-869-1375 or deckmaster@deckmaster.com. Failing to use the correct Deckmaster may void the warranty. Do not overdrive the screws.
